- 5. Interview will be conducted on the pre-scheduled dates.
- 6. Final results (list of scholars) will be announced and published on OPJEMS website.
- 7. Medals and certificates will be given to students on the date of Medal Ceremony.

The business case should provide an innovative and a sustainable solution to a major socio-economic problem faced by India in the current times / 21st century.

The solution proposed should adhere to Design Thinking parameters of Desirability, Feasibility, and Viability,

The business case should include the following:

- · An Executive Summary Objective of the case.
- · Background information about the problem for which the solution is proposed.
- Specific and clear description of the solution proposed benefits, limitations and associated risks related to the solution proposed.
- Financial forecast to ensure that every cost associated to the project is considered and the project is affordable.
- Proposals related to the Steel industry with digital solutions will earn additional points.
